

ITINERARY & IMPORTANT INFO

DAY 1-3 - WELCOME TO OZ

• SYDNEY Once you've landed in Sydney, the included airport transfer will pick you up and take you to our hostel, from there you will get to meet the rest of your travel group! We will spend 2 days exploring Sydney's iconic harbour landmarks and stunning beaches like Bondi with a coastal walk before we start our adventure north!

DAY 4-6 - SURFS UP!

• BYRON BAY The famous surf town of Byron Bay is where we will spend the next 3 nights. Aussie surfer dudes will teach you how to surf, you'll spot dolphins, relax and unwind with morning yoga and a beautiful sunrise walk to Cape Byron Lighthouse.

DAY 7-8 - BEACHES & PARTIES

• SURFERS PARADISE Surfers Paradise is the iconic spot for all your party and city vibes. Get back to nature as you take in the breathtaking views of Surfers Paradise's iconic coastline, paddling through the mangroves and spotting amazing wildlife on a SUP lesson and tour.

DAY 9-10 - BIG CITY & SUNSETS

• **BRISBANE** Queensland's capital is full of highlights for you to explore. You will get to chill out in 'The Lagoon', the only city man-made beach in Australia.

DAY 11-15 - 4X4 ISLAND SAFARI

• NOOSA & FRASER ISLAND (K'GARI) Noosa is the Aussie holiday favourite, and you're about to find out why. Famous for its laidback lifestyle and stunning beaches, you'll get to experience this as you kickback and relax before heading to Fraser Island (K'gari). You'll be driving your 4x4's around the biggest sand island in the world, and spend the next 3 days on sand dunes and beaches. Our next swim stop is the beautiful turquoise waters of Lake McKenzie, followed by a float down the river of Eli Creek. Indian Heads lookout is our next stop for 360 views of Fraser Island, then we get to chill in the bubbles of the Champagne Pools. You will learn about the history of the Aboriginal culture on the island, spot dingoes in the wild, and see the stars as you sleep in a purpose built campsite with your group. Arriving back in Noosa, we then get to explore the idyllic coastline on our way to the Fairy Pools, an Instagram-worthy spot you won't want to miss.

DAY 16-19 - SAIL TROPICAL ISLANDS

• AIRLIE BEACH & WHITSUNDAYS Once we hit Airlie beach, you'll get to enjoy some free time at the beachfront lagoon, before we begin sailing the stunning Whitsundays, made up of 74 tropical islands. We'll board our boat for the next 2 nights, relaxing and sunbathing on the massive deck as we sail to the outer parts of the Great Barrier Reef. See an abundance of marine life as you snorkel and stand-up paddle board on the fringing reefs. Next up is world-famous Whitehaven Beach, a stunning beach filled with swirls of fine white sand.

DAY 20-21 - ISLAND EXPLORING

• MAGNETIC ISLAND Magnetic Island is our next stop as we jump on a ferry to this tropical paradise. You'll stay in beachfront huts for the next 2 days as you explore this magical island. Hire a car and explore the hidden beaches, as well as hike up the historic Forts Walk, and chill out in your ocean front hammock. You may even spot wild koalas and wallabies!

DAY 22-23 - HEART-PUMPING ADVENTURE

 MISSION BEACH The chilled out beachfront town of Mission Beach is our next relaxation location. It's also filled with adrenaline pumping activities that you may choose to do, from skydiving at 15,000ft over the Great Barrier Reef and rainforests, or white water rafting on the Tully River Rapids through the World Heritage Rainforest.

DAY 24-28 - GREAT BARRIER REEF

• CAIRNS Welcome to the ultimate backpacker adventure hub, Cairns. It's time to tick off a huge bucket list item and spend a full day on the Great Barrier Reef. You'll spend the day sailing and snorkelling unique outer reef locations in this World Heritage listed site.

Exploring the Aussie oasis of the Atherton Tablelands is next for Cairns, where you will swim under waterfalls and dormant volcano craters, and slide down natural rock slides, all while learning about this extraordinary place from your experienced guide. The night will finish with a farewell dinner and drinks to toast to the incredible adventures and friends we have made.

Your epic Aussie adventure ends in Cairns on the morning of day 28, but we are here to help with onward travel or work in Oz for the rest of your time in Australia.

ARRIVAL INFORMATION

It's best to arrive on the actual start date as there's no activities on day one so you'll have time to check in and meet your group. If you do arrive in Sydney before your start date we will still organise your airport transfer and book you into the hostel from the day you arrive. Extra nights can be pre-paid with your agent or direct with us.

After Oz East Coast Adventure we'll make sure you're comfortable with what you're doing, where you're going and help you with everything you'll need to have the trip of a lifetime with the new friends you've made.

VISAS

You need a visa to enter Australia. Most people who do Oz East Coast Adventure are on either a Tourist Visa or a Working Holiday Visa if they are doing the Oz Jobs add-on.

TRAVEL INSURANCE

Although Australia is a relatively safe place, it is important that you cover yourself for the unexpected by arranging travel insurance before you go. Travel insurance is compulsory for this trip and you can organise a quote and policy for yourself <u>here</u>.

By doing Oz East Coast Adventure with the Work add-on you don't need to worry. We'll give you everything you need to find work in Australia including exclusive access to our own Oz Jobs Program.

Before You Start: We'll help sort all the important things you'll need before you start working in Australia. We'll assist you with opening up a local bank account for you with <u>Wise</u>, along with a SIM card, tax file number and assist with Medicare.

Training Courses: Certain jobs such as bar work and construction require you to complete specific training. We'll explain what's needed and can book you onto all necessary training courses after Oz East Coast Adventure.

Oz Jobs Program: With the Oz Jobs Add-on you'll get a lifetime membership to our Oz Jobs Program. This includes exclusive access to our INTRO Jobs App, where we post lots of great job opportunities everyday from our Australia wide network of employers.

Unlimited Help & Advice: Your group leader will give you a comprehensive 'Work in Oz' presentation, as well as one on one advice and support on CV building, job finding, interview skills and anything else you'll need to secure a great job in Australia.

Australia Wide Support: We have friendly staff in our Australian offices that will be there to support you and help you find work for the entire time you're in Oz.

Farm Work & 2nd & 3rd Year Visas: If you do 88 days of regional or farm work in Australia you can apply for a 2nd Working Holiday Visa. We'll give you lots more info on this during Oz East Coast Adventure, will help you find farm work and will also help you apply for your 2nd Year Visa.



DO MANY PEOPLE TRAVEL ALONE?

Yes. Lots of people on our trips are travelling solo. But by doing our trip you'll instantly be part of a group, so it's a great way to meet others and make friends!



CAN I CHAT TO MY GROUP BEFORE I LEAVE?

You can start chatting to people in your group and other travellers before you leave. Just go to our Facebook page, click on 'Groups' and choose <u>Australia</u>.



WHEN IS THE BEST TIME TO VISIT AUSTRALIA?

It's always a good time to go backpacking in Australia! It's generally quite hot in most parts of the country for the majority of the year except for the southern half of Australia during winter (June, July & August). But because Australia is such a big country when it's cold down south most people will head north and follow the sun!



IS THERE WI-FI THROUGHOUT THE TRIP?

Most accommodations we stay at have free Wi-Fi available. Australia's Wi-Fi network is usually quite good.



WHAT LUGGAGE DO YOU RECOMMEND?

We always recommend travelling with a backpack and packing light! 15-20kgs of stuff should be plenty. Australia is a BIG country so dragging around a huge bag is not fun.



DO I NEED A DRIVERS LICENSE?

To drive on Fraser Island (K'gari), you'll need to be over 21 years old with a full driving license and 3 years driving experience and will have to show your drivers license at the safety briefing at the hostel.



WHAT IS A WORKING HOLIDAY VISA

A Working Holiday Visa allows you to stay in Australia for up to 12 months. You are legally allowed to work with a WHV for each employer for up to 6 months, or 12 months in two different locations. Once your visa has been approved you have 12 months to use it. You must be aged 18-35. For more information on WHV, click <u>here</u>.



DO I NEED A CERTAIN AMOUNT OF MONEY TO ENTER AUSTRALIA?

You should have sufficient funds to support your trip. If you're on a WHV or have a return ticket out of Australia, then it's unlikely you'll be asked to show evidence. However, it is a good idea to have at least \$4,000AUD.



WHAT IS THE BEST WAY TO ACCESS MY MONEY?

If you're going to be working in Oz then you'll need an Aussie bank account. To open your bank account just go to the '<u>Manage My Booking</u>' section of our website. Your bank account will be set up with <u>Wise</u>. Australian employers will be able to pay you through this and you'll be able to use the Wise card to pay for things and withdraw cash at ATM's. If you transfer your money from home into Australian dollars you can avoid paying foreign exchange fees when you use the card.
