ITINERARY & IMPORTANT INFO

DAY 1 - ARRIVE IN AUCKLAND

• AUCKLAND Kia ora! Landing in Auckland, we'll meet you at our centrally located hostel to settle in. Tonight you'll meet up with the rest of your travel crew and get excited for all the adventures yet to come travelling New Zealand!

DAY 2 - AUCKLAND ORIENTATION

• AUCKLAND Today we'll get oriented with the beautiful city of Auckland. After doing some life admin and getting your local essentials set up, we'll then catch a ferry and travel to the beautiful Waiheke Island. This evening we see what Auckland's all about after dark! Don't forget to listen out for the local Kiwi accent to see if it lives up to its title as the 'World's Sexiest.'

DAY 3 - GLOWWORM CAVES & HOBBITON

• ROTORUA Leaving Auckland, we're off to discover the best of the beautiful North Island. Our first stop is Waitomo, home to the world-famous glowworm caves. We'll explore this surreal, subterranean landscape by boat, watching in awe as the glowworms light up the darkness. Next we're heading to Hobbiton, the real-life movie set featured in The Lord Of The Rings and Hobbit trilogies. After strolling through the enchanting village on a guided tour, we'll enjoy a drink at the Green Dragon Inn before departing for Rotorua.

DAY 4 - DISCOVER ROTORUA

• ROTORUA First on the agenda is Kerosene Creek, a naturally heated hot spring where we can laze away the morning. Next is one of New Zealand's most magnificent geothermal wonderlands – Wai o Tapu, featuring dramatic geysers & bubbling mud.

DAY 5 - MAORI CULTURAL EXPERIENCE

• ROTORUA This morning you'll have some free time to maybe try some zorbing or the skyline luge. In the evening we'll go to the Mitai Maori village for an authentic introduction to Maori culture. It doesn't get more authentic than this!

DAY 6 - TAUPO & SUNSET SAIL

• TAUPO Get your cameras out as we head to Taupo, a lakefront town right in the heart of the North. Tonight we've got something special lined up - a sunset sail across the lake. The majestic scenery will wow us, and the sunset will add a touch of magic.

DAY 7 - WATERFALLS & ADRENALINE

• TAUPO This morning we'll check out the epic Huka Falls, a spine-tingling torrent of icy water thundering down from the Waikato River. After witnessing the raw power of Mother Nature, you'll then have some free time when you can do a skydive or the world's highest bungee jump!

DAY 8 - CHILL OUT IN AUCKLAND

 AUCKLAND Today we'll head back to where it all started in Auckland! Spend the afternoon relaxing, checking out the sights, and getting ready for the trip down south tomorrow.

DAY 9 - FLY TO QUEENSTOWN

• QUEENSTOWN Catch a short flight to Queenstown and we'll meet you at the airport and take you to our hostel in the city. We'll head out for dinner tonight and get excited for our new adventure in the South Island!

DAY 10 - QUEENSTOWN JET BOATING

• QUEENSTOWN Today we'll show you around stunning Queenstown. The good news is that our first jolt of adrenaline isn't far off, as this afternoon we'll rush through Skippers Canyon at over 80 km/h on a jet boat ride. Tonight we'll see what Queenstown has to offer after dark!

DAY 11 - MILFORD SOUND CRUISE

• TE ANAU Leaving Queenstown, today we're heading to the majestic Milford Sound. We'll hop on a boat to cruise around the fjord, feeling tiny amongst sheer cliff faces, ancient forests, and plunging waterfalls. This evening we'll get cosy in Te Anau, a town in the heart of Fiordland.

DAY 12 - TRAVEL TO WANAKA

• WANAKA After soaking up the Tolkien-esque vistas and taking thousands of photos we'll arrive in Wanaka, a dreamy resort town hugging the sapphire lake.

DAY 13 - DISCOVER WANAKA

• WANAKA Today we'll check out the highlights of Wanaka, including going kayaking on the stunning Lake Wanaka and discovering the famous Wanaka Tree. We'll later hike up Mount Iron for stunning 360 degree views of the local area including The Pisa range, Upper Clutha Basin and the mesmerising Southern Alps.

DAY 14 - AORAKI/MT COOK

• LAKE TEKAPO We'll enjoy a scenic drive through the southern alps towards Tekapo. Known for its milky turquoise hue, Lake Tekapo is an alpine oasis! This afternoon we'll stretch our limbs hiking the iconic Hooker Valley track. This walk winds us through the valley to grant unforgettable views of Aoraki/Mt Cook, the highest mountain in New Zealand.

DAY 15 - LAKE TEKAPO

• LAKE TEKAPO Today we'll take a hike up Mt John where we'll get 360-degree views of the Southern Alps before soaking our tired muscles in some hot pools.

DAY 16 - ONWARD TRAVEL PLANS

• QUEENSTOWN After travelling back to buzzing Queenstown, securing you a paid job in NZ is on the agenda for today for those with the NZ Intro add-on. Our team will help make sure you've got everything sorted for living and working in NZ, and get you signed up to our NZ Jobs program. Tonight we'll get together one last time for our farewell dinner.

DAY 17 - CHECK OUT

ARRIVAL INFORMATION

It's best to arrive on the actual start date as there's no activities on day one so you'll have plenty of time to check in, relax and meet your group. If you do arrive early, you can book and pay for extra nights of the accommodation we use with your agent or in the <u>Manage My Booking</u> area.

AFTER NZ 17 DAY

During the 17 days of the trip you'll get lots of help with finding work, accommodation and your onward travel. We'll make sure you're comfortable with what you're doing, where you're going and help you with everything you'll need to have the trip of a lifetime.

VISAS

If you're planning a short holiday and are from Australia, the UK, Canada, USA, or any of the countries on this list, you do not need a visa to enter but do require an NZ ETA (New Zealand Electronic Travel Authority) which can be requested online. We can help organise this before you go.

If you are doing the NZ Intro add-on you will need a Working Holiday Visa. A WHV is usually available to those aged 18 - 30 and valid for 12 or 23 months.

TRAVEL INSURANCE

Your group leader will ask to see proof of your cover before your trip begins. You can organise travel insurance here or contact us.

HOW WILL I ACCESS MY MONEY WHILE I'M AWAY?

If you're going to be working in NZ, you'll need an NZ bank account. To open your bank account just go to the Manage My Booking section of our website. Your bank account will be set up with Wise. NZ employers will be able to pay you through this. If you're on a tourist visa you'll be able to use the Wise travel currency card to pay for things and withdraw cash at ATM's. There are ATM's available throughout New Zealand so it's easy to access cash.



IS THERE WI-FI THROUGHOUT THE TRIP?

All accommodations we stay at have free Wi-Fi available. New Zealand's Wi-Fi is generally good.
