



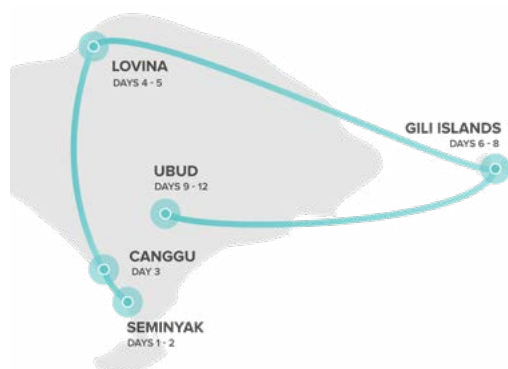

ITINERARY & IMPORTANT INFO

DAY 1 - ARRIVE IN SEMINYAK

• **SEMINYAK** Landing in bustling Seminyak, we'll meet you at the airport and take you to your hotel. Meet up with your travel crew and get excited for the adventures to come.

DAY 2 - TEMPLES & CULTURE

• **SEMINYAK** Today we pay a visit to the ancient temples in Uluwatu, then take part in a Bahasa Indonesian lesson and learn how to create a Canang Sari (a local offering). As sunset falls we'll sip drinks and eat dinner at one of Uluwatu trendiest beach clubs, then head back to Seminyak for a night out.

DAY 3 - LEARN TO SURF

• **CANGGU** Our last morning in Seminyak will be spent hitting the waves, where you'll learn to surf with the help of local Balinese instructors. We'll then head on to one of the world's most iconic surfing destinations, where your sleek boutique hotel awaits. Dig your toes into the volcanic sand, or just chill out poolside.

DAY 4 - EXPLORING LOVINA

• **LOVINA** Untouched and relatively unknown, Lovina will steal your heart with its rolling rice paddies and smiley welcome. On the way we'll squeeze in some temple exploring and a dip in a waterfall before arriving at our unique accommodation, set high in the mountains with views of rice paddies and the ocean.

DAY 5 - DOLPHIN SPOTTING & LOCAL LIFE

• **LOVINA** It's all aboard a traditional outrigger boat today as we cruise the coastline on the lookout for wild dolphins. Back on land, we'll then visit a local family where you'll learn the art of basket weaving and get a unique insight into traditional Balinese life. Keen to chill? The infinity pool of our luxury villa has your name all over it...

DAY 6 - HELLO PARADISE

• **GILI T** Crystal clear waters and swaying palm trees are on the agenda today as we catch the fast ferry to Gili T, the largest of the three Gili Islands. With a free afternoon feel yourself slipping easily into island time, Bintang in hand, before a night out island style.

DAY 7 - TIME TO CHILL

• **GILI T** With no motorised vehicles on Gili T, today we'll explore the island on two wheels, beach hopping from one sandy shore to the next.

DAY 8 - GILI ISLANDS BOAT TRIP & SNORKELLING

• **GILI T** Travelling by boat, today we'll explore the beauty of the Gili Islands, stopping along the way for plenty of snorkel breaks to spot turtles and other colourful marine life. At dinner tonight, we'll toast to our time on the Gili's, as tomorrow it's back to the mainland.

DAY 9 - TRAVEL TO UBUD

• **UBUD** Waving goodbye to paradise, the chilled out cultural Mecca of Ubud awaits as we travel back to the mainland by ferry.

DAY 10 - MONKEY FOREST & COOKING CLASS

• **UBUD** You've seen the pictures, now experience Ubud's famous Monkey Forest for real! A centuries old temple overrun by monkeys, today's your chance to get up close to these mischievous primates. Monkey selfie captured, we'll then learn how to cook some of Bali's best dishes with a hands on cooking class.

DAY 11 - SUNRISE VOLCANO TREK & TRADITIONAL MASSAGE

• **UBUD** It's an early start this morning as we head out before dawn for a once-in-a-lifetime sunrise trek. Joined by a Local Guide, hike up an active volcano and summit just as the sun peaks over the horizon for breakfast with a view. Arriving back around mid morning, this afternoon relax and unwind with a traditional Balinese massage.

DAY 12 - CHECK OUT & ONWARD TRAVEL

• **UBUD** Your unforgettable 12 day adventure comes to an end today. Those flying home will make their way to the airport, or keep living the dream and extend your stay in Bali with our help and the new friends you've made.

ARRIVAL INFORMATION

It's best to arrive on the actual start date, as that's when most people get in. While there are no activities on the first day, the group usually meets up for dinner around 7pm. We also recommend arriving before 3pm to avoid traffic. If you do arrive early, we'll still pick you up from the airport if you're staying at our accommodation. You can book and pay for extra nights accommodation in the [Manage My Booking](#) area.

AFTER BALI EXPERIENCE

The Bali Experience 12 day finishes in Ubud. You can choose to stay on longer in Bali or if you need to get back to the airport then it's a simple taxi transfer that will take around 1- 1.5 hours. The earliest we recommend booking an onward flight out of Bali is around 1pm on your final day.

Your group leader will ensure any other local transport is sorted and you are comfortable with all parts of your trip and your onward travel.

VISAS

A visa on arrival (VOA) for Bali is available to citizens of over [90 countries](#). The VOA can be obtained upon arrival in Bali and travellers must provide the relevant documentation as well as pay the VOA application fee of IDR 500,000 (\$35 USD). You will need at least 6 months remaining validity and 2 blank pages in your passport. It's also recommended to have onward travel booked out of Bali before travelling there, as you may get asked for proof of this before boarding your flight to Bali. We recommend checking with your local Indonesian consulate for up to date visa requirements and costs.

TRAVEL INSURANCE

Travel insurance for Bali is compulsory to join Bali Experience. Your group leader will ask to see proof of your cover before your trip begins. You can organize your travel insurance [here](#).

DO MANY PEOPLE TRAVEL ALONE?

Yes. Lots of people on our trips are travelling solo. But by doing our trip you'll instantly be part of a group, so it's a great way to meet others and make friends! Most of our accommodation is twin or triple share, so we will put you in a room with someone of the same gender.



WHAT'S A PREMIUM TRIP?

CAN I CHAT TO MY GROUP BEFORE I LEAVE?

HOW WILL I ACCESS MY MONEY WHILE I'M AWAY?

We recommend getting a travel currency card through [Wise](#). You can use the Wise card almost everywhere and withdraw cash and use it with Google or Apple Pay. If you transfer your money into the local currency, you can avoid paying foreign exchange fees when you use the card. There are ATM's available throughout Bali and some places only accept cash.



CAN I CHANGE MY START DATE?

Enjoy ultimate peace of mind and flexibility with INTRO. Should your travel plans change or be disrupted you can change your start date or tour for free up to 30 days before your start date.



IS THERE WI-FI THROUGHOUT THE TRIP?

All accommodations we stay at have free Wi-Fi available. Indonesia's network quality is often lower than you're used to but you can generally connect and do basic stuff.



WHEN IS THE BEST TIME TO VISIT BALI?

The great thing about Bali is it's usually quite hot all year round, so it's great to go at any time. There are generally 2 broad seasons in Bali. April to September is usually dry and hot. October to March is slightly cooler with a slightly higher chance of rain, but this rain is often only for an hour or so, which can be a nice relief from the heat.
