How will I find a job?

How much money do I need for food and drinks whilst on tour?

Because accommodation, activities and some meals and drinks are included, we suggest to bring around \$200-\$250 spending money.

What is the average age of people on tour?

Do I need a visa to come to Australia?

Yes you do! If you're just visiting Australia, you'll need a Visitor Visa. If you also want to work, you'll need a Working Holiday Visa (417) or a Work and Holiday Visa (462) depending on where you're from.
