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DAY 2 - GLOWWORM CAVES & HOBBITON

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VISAS

If you're planning a short holiday and are from Australia, the UK, Canada, USA, or any of the [countries on this list](#), you do not need a visa to enter but do require an [NZ ETA](#) (New Zealand Electronic Travel Authority) which can be requested online. We can help organise this before you go.

If you are doing the NZ Intro work add-on you will need a Working Holiday Visa. A WHV is usually available to those aged 18 - 30 (or up to 35 for certain countries) and valid for 12 or 23 months (or 36 months if you are from UK).

If you're on a tourist visa you'll be able to use the Wise travel currency card to pay for things and withdraw cash at ATM's. There are ATM's available throughout New Zealand so it's easy to access cash.

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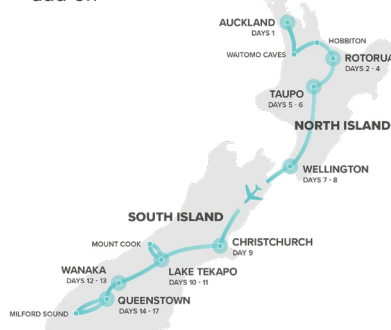
